Direct cremation is a no fuss, no service funeral – no family or mourners are present.

Families typically choose direct cremation when planning a memorial, celebration of life or scattering / interment of ashes at a different time – and they do not want the cremation to be the main focus of the funeral.

It can also be a choice previously expressed by the person who has died, this is becoming more common due to influential media advertising.

## Direct Cremation Summary

### The cost of a Direct Cremation

John Edwards Funeral Directors fee: £950 + disbursements

- Comprehensive support and guidance to organise the direct cremation
- Collection of your loved one to be taken to private mortuary\*
- Our fee includes a simple coffin
- Transportation of your loved one direct to the crematorium
- We will let you know the date and time of the committal
- We collect the ashes, we will then arrange for you to collect the ashes from one of our offices

Disbursements for this type of funeral are typically:

- Crematorium fee: £350 ( Crematorium TBA)
- Doctors' fee for cremation forms: £82 (not required if HM Coroner involved)

\* Out of hours collection 5pm – 9am, weekends and bank holidays incur an additional £195 fee

\* Home collection or nursing home collection incur an additional £195 fee

\* Our direct cremation service only applies to collections within a 10-mile radius
